

# THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE

BY-LAW No. 1339-10

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE VOTE BY MAIL AS AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF VOTING FOR THE 2010 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

**WHEREAS** *Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, as amended,* provides that a municipal council may, on or before June 1 in the year of the election, pass a by-law authorizing an alternative voting method; and

**WHEREAS** *Section 42, Subsection 3 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, c.32, as amended,* requires the Clerk of a municipality to establish procedures and forms for any alternative voting method authorized by by-law; and


**WHEREAS** *Section 42, Subsection 5 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, c.32, as amended,* provides that a municipal council may use alternative voting methods in lieu of advance votes and voting proxies; and


**WHEREAS** Council deems it appropriate and in the public interest to conduct the Year 2010 Municipal Election using the Vote by Mail method at the municipal elections;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. **THAT** the use of Vote by Mail, as an alternative voting method, is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held on Monday, October 25, 2010.
2. **THAT** the Clerk shall establish appropriate procedures for the use of Vote by Mail for the 2010 Municipal Elections.
3. **THAT** the provisions relating to proxy voting and requirements for an advance poll shall not apply in the 2010 Municipal Election.
4. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing hereof.
