1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

An employee of the Municipality of Red Lake, the Equipment Operator I will operate light and medium-duty equipment to assist in construction, maintenance and repair of public infrastructure.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES

- To operate designated heavy equipment for the maintenance and construction of the Municipal Road systems.
- To operate all necessary equipment to repair the Municipal water and sewer system.
- To perform routine inspections and maintenance equipment to ensure functionality, including checking fluids, greasing parts and reporting malfunctions.
- Load and transport construction materials, earth and other heavy items to and from job sites.
- Operate equipment with high degree of accuracy for tasks requiring precise measurements and adjustments.
- Maintain Municipal property and facilities to Municipal standards.
- Promote positive attitude toward safe and responsible work practices and must meet the standards of the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

6. WORKING RELATIONSHIP

- Regular communication with the Operations Department

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7. SKILLS REQUIRED

- High School Diploma
- Posses a valid Ontario DZ driver's license.
- Effective communication skills and ability to work well within a team.
